11/11 3rd Commandment:
Meaning

We should fear and love God
so that we do not despise
preaching and His Word, but
hold it sacred and gladly hear
and learn it.

11/18 4th Commandment

Honor your father and your
mother.

12/9 4th Commandment:
Meaning

We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.

12/16 5th Commandment

You shall not murder.

1/6 5th Commandment:
Meaning

We should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical need.

1/13 6th Commandment

You shall not commit adultery.

1/27 6th Commandment:
Meaning

We should fear and love God so that we lead a sexually pure and decent life in what we say and do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.

2/3 7th Commandment

You shall not steal.

2/10 7th Commandment:
Meaning Part I

We should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way,

2/17 7th Commandment:
Meaning Part II

but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.

2/24 8th Commandment

You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

3/9 8th Commandment:
Meaning Part I

We should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation,

3/16 8th Commandment:
Meaning Part II

but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.

3/30 9th Commandment

You shall not covet your neighbor's house.

4/6 9th Commandment:
Meaning

We should fear and love God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor ' s inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it.

4/13 10th Commandment

You shall not cover your neighbor ' s wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

4/20 10th Commandment:
Meaning

We should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor ' s wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.
